Hi Tolli and Sam and Elizabeth, at the February NIPA meeting we discussed the request from Kootenai Health to have a pride month event in June hosted by Kootenai. I am happy to take the lead on organizing the event. I can do a health care forum similar to our Inclusive Care events the past two years (LGBTQ health care and Trans health care) or we could do something different. We will be having inclusive care programs in May and August (they are quarterly but not falling in June this year) so it may be nice to do something a little different?

My preliminary idea is a forum with short presentations from leaders of local and regional groups dedicated to LGBTQIA+ population- NIPA, Silver Valley Pride, Sandpoint Pride, the new PFLAG chapter on important issues surrounding this population? We could have it in the evening at 5 or at noon and if we can get it in someone's budget maybe have a bit of food available.
